Dear Parents

SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY - PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTIONS

There is a vacancy for a parent governor on the school's governing body. The term of office is 4 years. The governing body plays a significant part in the development and management of the school and as such, parent governors play an important role as members of the governing body helping to form policy, set priorities and manage the budget.

I am therefore writing to invite you either to nominate yourself or to nominate a parent to fill the vacancy. A nomination form is enclosed. If you would like to nominate someone please return the completed form to the school by Friday 9th October 2009.

The person nominated must, on the date that nominations close, be a parent of a registered pupil at the school.

Please note that you are not eligible to be a parent Governor if you are;

1. An elected member of the Local Authority
2. Paid to work at the school for more than 500 hours in any twelve month period commencing 1st August and finishing 31st July.

No parent may propose and/or second more nominations than there are vacancies. Parents being nominated are invited to give on the nomination form some brief biographical details suitable for inclusion in the voting paper.

If the number of nominations received is the same as, or fewer than, the number of vacancies to be filled then those nominated will be elected unopposed. If all the vacancies are not filled in this way the governing body will have to appoint parent governors to the vacancy/vacancies. If this should be necessary such appointees need not be parents of children at this school.

If there are more nominations than vacancies the election will be by secret ballot. If that is necessary voting papers will be sent to you together with details about the ballot procedure.
